Subject:- Special family pensionary awards and Disability pension.

Sir,

I am directed to say that, in partial modification of the orders contained in this Ministry's letter No. 195163/Pen-C, dated the 17th September 1965, on the above subject mentioned above, the President has been pleased to decide that in the case of Service personnel (including Army Postal Service and the Defence Security Corps) below commissioned rank, where the special family pensionary awards and disability pension admissible under these orders are less than one and half times the awards admissible under the Pension Regulations payment will be made at one and a half times the rates laid down in the Regulations plus ad hoc increase, if admissible, subject to the condition that in no case does the total exceed the basic pay last drawn by the individual.

2. This issues with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance (Def) vide their U.O. No. 3365-Addl. F.A. II of 1965.
