Tam directed to say that the President has been pleased to decide that service officers and personnel(including Army Postal Service and Defence Security Corps personnel) who are killed or who are invalided out of service on account of injuries sustained (a) as a result of fighting in warlike operations or border skinmishes either with Pakistan on the cease-fire line or any other country; (b) while fighting against armed hostiles like Nagas and Mizos; (c) during fighting in service with peace keeping missions abroad, shall for purposes of special family pensionary awards and disability pension be governed by the orders contained in this Ministry's letters No.195163/Pen-C dated the 17th September 1965 and the 7th October 1965.

- These orders have effect from the date of issue of the order.
