Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. 200847/Pen-C/71 dated 24th February 1972 regarding liberalised pensionary awards to war widows and war disabled servicemen and to say that the President has been pleased to decide, in modification of all the existing orders, that all temporary and ad-hoc increases (including reliefs and ad-hoc reliefs) already sanctioned and to be sanctioned in future will be admissible, with effect from 1st January 1981, to all the existing and future pensioners (including family pensioners), governed by the liberalised pensionary awards promulgated in the above-quoted letter, under the same conditions as are applicable to normal pensioners.

- 2. Ad-hoc grant, if any, sanctioned in accordance with the provisions of this Ministry's Corrigendum No.A/41519/AG/PS4(d)/1348/Pen-C dated 22nd February 1978, will not be admissible with effect from 1st January, 1981.
