OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Increase in the minimum amount of pension/family pension (including relief) payable to low paid pensioners.

The undersigned is directed to say that the question of providing some financial relief to low paid pensioners has been under consideration of the Government. It has been decided that decided that, while the amount of pension/family pension and relief payable to retired Central Government servants and their families under the relevant Rules/Orders, would continue to be determined as at present, the total amount (pension plus relief) so arrived at would be, where necessary, stepped up so that the total amount payable in the case of superannuation/retiring/involved. retiring/invalid/compensation pension is not less than Rs. 150/- per month. In the case of family pension payable under Liberalised Pension Rules, 1950. Family Pension Scheme 1964 and Central Civil Services (Extra-Ordinary Pension) Rules, the amount of amily pension and relief may also be stepped up to Ps. 140/- per month. No stepping up will, thus, be required where the normal entitlement (including instalments of modical descriptions) of relief that may be sanctioned here-after) works out to the above-mentioned amounts or more. In the case of persion payment orders to be issued in future, the amounts of pension/ family pension and relief payable under the existing rules and orders would continue to be shown at the appropriate place in the relevant PPOs as at present. However, the following note may be recorded against these amounts for enabling the Pengion disbursing authorities to arrange payment of pension family pension at the enhanced amount to the concernce pensioners or receipients of family pension:

Stepped up to Rs. 150/140 per month till normal entitlement (Persion/family pension plus isitef) itself adds upto Rs.150/140 per month or more.

In cases where the PPOs have already been issued, a similar note will be made by the rension disbursing authorites with proper attestation. These authorities will also arrange payment of pension/family pension plus relief at the enhanced rate on the basis of this Office New Tendum.

The benefits of these orders will be admissible in the case of pension falling due on 1st April, 1982 or thereafter.

In their application to persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller and Anditor General of India.
