Sir,

2. The Ministry of Defence letter referred to in the preceding para authorises Pension Disbursing Authorities/Treasuries/Pension Pay Masters/Banks/Post Offices to refix the pension and pay the arrears in respect of personnel below officer rank (excepting (i) those whose pension is less than Rs. 41; (ii) Reservists and (iii) Subedar, Majors of Army, Master Chief Petty Officers Class I & II of Navy and Warrant Officers and Master Warrant Officers of the Air Force who retired during 25.2.1978 and 30.3.1979) who opt for revision of pension on the basis of the ready reckoner. Applications from the pensioners of this category who opt for revision of pension with reference to service records or where pensioners are not eligible to exercise an option or where the pensioners were granted pension of the lower rank for not having rendered the then prescribed minimum service in the rank last held and applications from Commissioned Officers etc. (indicated in para 1 above) for whom Tables have been devised, would be sent by the Pension Disbursing Authorities (PDAs) to the Controller of Defence Accounts (Pensions), Allahabad. The Controller of Defence Accounts (Pensions) will revise pension in the above cases, calculate gross payments due on account of revised pension and reliefs admissible thereon from 1.4.1979 to the end of the month preceding the date of revision and authorise the PDA concerned to pay arrears after deducting payments already made on account of pension and reliefs. The CDA(P) will also issue necessary corrigendum to the Pension Certificate/Pension Payment Order. No revision of pension or authorisation should be made by the PDAs on their own under these covers. The PDAs will be responsible to deduct payments already made on account of pension and reliefs from 1.4.1979 to the end of the month preceding the date of revision by the CDA(P) from the gross payments on account of revised pension and reliefs admissible thereon as intimated by the CDA(P), and will make payment of the balance amounts due.

3. In the case of personnel below officer rank where the pensioner becomes entitled to pension of the higher rank due to the application of the 10-month rank rule, the Controller of Defence Accounts (Pensions), Allahabad will find out from the service records the qualifying service rendered by the individual and the pension that would have been admissible to him in the higher rank, in case the 10-month rank rule was then applicable. He will then find out the revised pension for that pension of the higher rank from Annex to this letter or the ready reckoner, circulated with this Ministry's letter No. 14/82/Pension/Services) dated the 22nd November, 1983.

4. Where the revised pension of a pensioner will not benefit him as it is either equal to or less than his existing pension, his pension will not be revised even though he may have applied for its revision and/or exercised option for revision of pension based on actual calculations with reference to service records. In such cases the Controller of Defence Accounts (Pensions), Allahabad will inform the pensioner suitably.
