Subject:- Calculation of the length of qualifying service for
assessment of pension/certainty in respect of Service
personnel including Commissioned Officers.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the President is pleased to decide
that in calculating the length of qualifying service for the purpose
of pensionary benefits, a fraction of a year equal to three months
and above shall be treated as a completed one half-year and reckoned
as qualifying service for determining the amount of pension and
service/D.R.G.

2. These orders will have effect from 20th June, 1983.

3. The existing provisions of the Pension Regulations for
three services may be deemed to have been amended in this respect
to the extent of the provisions of these orders. Formal amendment
to the aforesaid Regulations will be issued in due course.

4. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Division
of this Ministry vide their U.O. No. 2748/Pen of 1984.
