Sir, I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. 1(4)/82/D(Pension/Services) dated 22.11.83 on the above subject and to say that the pensioners with reckonable emoluments up to Fs. 1000/-(excepting those whose pension is less than Rs. 41) were required to exercise their option to receive pension either as per the ready reckoners referred to in para 6 of the letter ibid or to receive pension with reference to actual calculations to based on service records. The option was required to be exercised by the affected pensioners within a period of 6 months from the date of issue of the letter. The President has now been pleased to decide that this option may now be exercised up to 31st Desember, 1984. There will be no time limit in the case of those pensioners who are not covered by the ready reckoners referred to in para 6 of the letter dated 22.11.83 ibid and in whose case pension is required to be revised by CDA(P) based on service records.
