Subject;- Policy regarding grant of family pension in respect of Service Officers permanently absorbed in PSUs/autonomous bodies.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. 32(4)/78/2032/D/D(Pension/Services) dated 1.11.80 on the subject and to state that doubts have been expressed in various quarters with regard to interpretation/implication of sub-para (c) of para 1 thereof .

2. It is hereby clarified that such Service Officers as were ineligible to join the Employees Family Pension Scheme, 1971 on account of their pay being more than Rs.1600/-p.m. at the time of the absorption, may be allowed the benefits of Family Pension Scheme in accordance with the rules/instructions applicable to them before their absorption.
