 Subject: Rationalisation of Pension structure for pre-1.1.1986 Armed Forces pensioners-
 Implementation of Government decisions on the recommendations of the Fourth
 Central Pay Commission.

Sir,
 I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 12th May 1987 on
 the above subject and to convey the sanction of the President to the following:

- (i) In respect of those Armed Forces officers and personnel whose reckonable emoluments were
 more than Rs.1,000/- p.m., the retiring pension/ service pension/invalid
 pension/service element of disability pension and War Injury Pay as on 1.1.1986 shall be
 finally consolidated after taking into account the benefit, if any, arising out of
 recomputation of their pension at 50% of their reckonable emoluments for 33 years of
 reckonable qualifying service (hereinafter referred to as the "50% formula"), without
 there being any calling on the amount thus arrived at. For this purpose, the same
 reckonable emoluments and reckonable qualifying service shall be taken into account, based
 on which their pension was initially fixed.
- (ii) With effect from 1.1.1986, the rates of disability element for 100% disability in non-
 battle casualty cases shall be as follows for existing disability pensioners:

Rank	Amount p.m.
(a) Commissioned officers & Honorary Commissioned officers	Rs. 750/-
(b) Junior Commissioned officers and equivalent ranks	Rs. 550/-
(c) Other ranks & non-combatants (Enrolled) and equivalent ranks	Rs. 450/-

Where the disability of a pensioner is less than 100%, but not less than 20%, the rates of
 disability element will be proportionately reduced. The aforesaid rates shall also be applicable
 to the following categories of pensioners:

- (a) Officers of the Military Nursing Service
 (b) Personnel below officer rank of the Defence Security Corps
 (c) Officers and personnel below officer rank of the Territorial Army who have been
 sanctioned disability and service elements of pension separately.
 (iii) With effect from 1.1.1986, the calling of disability element of War Injury Pay for 100
 per cent disability in battle casualty cases, shall be raised to Rs.1,000 p.m. for the
 existing pensioners in receipt of War Injury Pay, and in no case it shall be less than the
 revised rates indicated in sub para (ii) above, applicable in non-battle casualty cases. For
 lower percentages of disability, the disability element shall be proportionately reduced.
 (iv) With effect from 1.1.1986, constant attendance allowance in all eligible battle/non-
 battle casualty cases shall be paid at the revised rates of Rs.300/- p.m. irrespective of the rank.
 2. The Pension Disbursing Authorities (PDAs) including Public Sector Banks disbursing
 defence pension, are hereby authorised to re-link the consolidated pension with effect from
 1.1.1986 in the light of the above decisions, in respect of the categories and subject to the
 conditions set out in the succeeding paragraphs. The PDAs shall carry out such re-linking
 without any further authorisation from the concerned Pension Sanctioning Authority (PSA) and
 pay the arrears on account of such re-linking except in those cases which are required to be
 referred to the PSAs/Record Officers as mentioned hereinafter.

3. RETIRING PENSION/SERVICE PENSION/INVALID PENSION/SERVICE ELEMENT
 OF DISABILITY PENSION/WAR INJURY PAY.

3.1 In respect of those pensioners whose reckonable emoluments were Rs.1000/- or less,
 pension was *ad-hoc* fixed at 50% of the reckonable emoluments for 33 years of qualifying
 service, or would have been so revised, if due, with effect from 1.4.1979 in accordance with
 this Ministry's letters No. 1(4)/82(D)(Pension/Services) dated 22nd November 1983 and No.
 1(4)/82(D)(Pension/Services) dated 3rd December 1983 as amended vide Corrigena No.
 1(15)/84(A/D)(Pension/Services) dated 11th February 1986 and 30th May 1986, issued in
 pursuance of the Supreme Court Judgment dated 17th December, 1982. Therefore, in such
 cases no additional benefit will accrue as a result of recomputation of pension at 50% of the
 reckonable emoluments.

3.2 For the pensioners whose reckonable emoluments were more than Rs.1000/- tables
 indicating the Existing Pension (EP), pension recomputed by application of the 50% formula
 (RP) and the corresponding Revised Consolidated Pension (RCP) are given as indicated below:

Notes: 1 It may be noted that application of the 50% formula does not result in increased rate of pension (RP) in all the cases.

2 In the case of TA personnel below officer rank whose reckonable emoluments were more than Rs. 1000/- revision of pension by application of the 50% formula will be made by CDA/PP, Madras, after imposing a 5 per cent cut wherever applicable.

ACTION BY THE PDAs

3.3 The PDAs should arrive at the revised consolidated pension (RCP) in the cases covered by the Tables as under:-

- (a) The PDAs should first see the Rank, date of commencement of pension and the amount of basic pension (before commutation) from the Pension Payment Order and their allied records.
- (b) The aforesaid amount of basic pension before Commutation should exclude other elements

such as personal pension, ad hoc ex-gratia amount, temporary increase, ad hoc increase, ad hoc relief and dearness relief.

The PDAs should then see whether the table relevant for that rank/group and date of retirement contains exactly the same rate of pension under the column 'Existing Pension (EP)'. If it does, the corresponding revised consolidated pension (RCP) shown against that rate of existing pension in that table for that rank/group/period will be the revised consolidated pension (RCP) (retiring pension/vice pension/invalid pension/service element of disability pension/war injury pay as the case may be). In such cases, this revised consolidated pension (RCP) will replace the rates fixed in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid.* for cases of retiring pension/service pension and invalid pension, and the PDAs should pay the arrears of account of such relaxation and intimate the CDA/Pensions), in the form prescribed in Annexure 'A'. For disability pensioners, the rate of revised consolidated service element thus arrived at should then be taken into account for relaxation of revised disability pension in the manner stated in para 4 below.

(d) In cases where revised consolidated pension cannot be arrived at by the PDAs because the rate of pension authorised by the concerned PSA does not exactly tally with that shown in the relevant table, the PDA should refer the case to the PSA concerned in the manner prescribed in para 14.3 below.

ACTION BY PSAs

3.4 In the categories of cases mentioned at para 3.3(d) above, on receipt of communication from PDAs in regard to relaxation of pension, the PSAs should authorise the revised consolidated pension, keeping in view the following:-

- (a) In cases where pension had been sanctioned under specific Government orders after imposing a cut on pensionary benefits, the PSAs should impose a cut to the same extent before issuing the revised PPOs. For this purpose, it will not be necessary to obtain revised Government sanction in individual cases.
- (b) For any shortfall in the standard period of service in case of commissioned officer deduction should be made by the PSAs, as hitherto, before issuing the PPO.
- (c) The amount of invalid pension should be arrived at in the same manner, after deduction of proportionate reduction, as hitherto.
- (d) In cases involving consolidated/reductions vide (a), (b) or (c) above, the revised consolidated pension should be arrived at by the PSAs through the following steps:-

- (i) Cuts/reductions/reductions should be made from the pension (recomputed application of the 50% formula (4P) and not from the revised consolidated pension (RCP), as shown in the Tables.
- (ii) Additional relief in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 should, however, be computed on the existing rate of pension (including the commutation, temporary increase, Ad hoc increase and Ad hoc relief, if any already sanctioned by PSAs.
- (iii) The pension should then be consolidated as per instructions contained in para 6 of Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid.*

4. DISABILITY PENSION

The following procedure should be followed for revision of Disability Pension:

PENSIONERS WHO RETIRED IN THE OFFICERS' RANK

4.1 The pensioners in receipt of Disability Pension should apply directly to the concerned PSAs in the manner prescribed in para 14.1 below. On receipt of such applications, the PSAs should notify the revised Disability Pension to the Pension Disbursing Authority.

PENSIONERS BELOW OFFICERS' RANK

Action by the Pensioners

4.2 The affected Disability Pensioners may apply to their respective Record Offices or application form prescribed at Annexure B of this letter in order to expedite action/revision of disability pension.

Action by the Record Offices

4.3(a) Record Offices should identify the existing Disability Pensioners and complete the proforma (except the PDA particulars and the TSHO number) prescribed at Annexure C of this letter. In quadruplicate, without waiting for the receipt of the applications from the pensioners. The proforma should be completed strictly with reference to the Pension Payment Orders issued by the PSAs and the Sheet Rolls. After the proforma have been completed by the ROs in all affected cases (except old cases referred to in (b) below), a message should be sent to the concerned Pension Sanctioning Authority regarding completion of this work.

(b) The proforma in which column 7 cannot be completed due to some reason or the other, such as the disability element not having been shown separately in the PPO, should be referred to the concerned PSA forthwith.

Action by the Pension Sanctioning Authorities.

4.4 On receipt of the message from the Record Offices concerned, the Pension Sanctioning Authority should depute Accounts Officer(s) authorised to sign the PPOs, to authenticate the proforma and emboss the seal of the PSA on the original copy of the proforma.

Further Action by the Record Offices

4.5 The Record Offices should make available the affected Pension Payment Orders and the Sheet Rolls to the Accounts Officer's deputed by the Pension Sanctioning Authority alongwith any other documents required for verification before authentication of the proforma. After the proforma have been authenticated by the Accounts Officers, the triplicate copies should be handed over to the Accounts Officers for record of the PSA. The PDA particulars and TSHO number should be filed in in other copies with reference to the applications received from the pensioners. The original and duplicate copies of the proforma should thereafter be despatched to the concerned Pension Disbursing Authority by the Record Offices and their acknowledgement obtained.

Action by the Pension Disbursing Authority

4.6 On receipt of the original and duplicate copies of the proforma (Annexure C) from the Record Offices, duly authenticated by the Accounts Officers of the concerned PSA, the following action should be taken by the PDAs--

- (a) **At the First Stage**
Determine the existing rate of the service element of pension (before commutation) by deducting the disability element of pension as intimated by the concerned Record Office in column 7(c) of the proforma at Annexure C from the total Disability Pension (before commutation).
- (b) See whether the pensioner belonged to one of the categories mentioned in para 3.2 above whose reckonable emoluments were more than Rs.1000/- and-
 - (i) If the pensioner belonged to such a category and the service element can be revised by the PDA on his own, as stated in para 3.3(c) above, the PDA will arrive at revised consolidated service element of disability pension and take this into account for arriving at revised disability pension as stated in (d) below.
 - (ii) If the pensioner belonged to such a category but the service element cannot be revised for reasons stated in para 3.3(d) above, the PDA will refer the case to concerned PSA as stated in para 3.3(d). In such cases the PSAs will notify the revised Disability Pension to the PDAs.
 - (iii) If the pensioner did not belong to such a category, the PDA will revise the service element of pension as follows:
 - aa) the existing service element before commutation,
 - bb) T/AH/AHR on the service element (arrived at by deducting the disability element from the total basic Disability Pension), wherever payable at the rates shown in Annexure D to this letter. In those cases where the pension was

stepped up to Rs.40/- p.m. w.a.1. 1.3.1970 and the service element is arrived at by deducting the disability element from the stepped up pension, only AHR, if payable. In addition to the stepped up pension will be taken.

cc) The total of the existing service element and T/AH/AHR, by adding (aa) and (bb)

dd) Consolidated amount of the revised service element of pension corresponding to the existing rate as determined at (cc) above, with reference to the table at Annexure 'C' of this letter.

At the Second Stage

(c) the PDA should increase the disability element to the rate as intimated by the R.O. in column 7(e) of the proforma at Annexure 'C'

Finally

(d) revise the total Disability Pension by adding the amount of service element arrived at vide (b) (ii)(b)(iii) above and the amount of disability element at (c) above.

(e) step up the total revised disability pension to Rs.375/- where the total arrived at vide (d) above is less than Rs.375/- . The revised consolidated service element arrived at vide (b) (iii) above should not be stepped up to Rs.375/- separately so long as the disability element is payable. In cases where service element is payable for life and it is worked out vide (b) (iii) above as less than Rs.375/-, should be stepped up to Rs.375/- on cessation of the disability element. In cases where disability element is reassessed subsequently, the revised amount of such disability element should first be added to the revised service element as arrived at vide (b) (iii) above and not to the stepped service element.

(f) In all cases of Disability Pension which are revised by the PDAs as above, a calculation sheet prescribed at Annexure F of this letter should be prepared by the PDAs in triplicate and the first two copies thereof together with duplicate copy of the proforma at Annexure 'C' should be forwarded to the Pay Commission Implementation cell, CDAP, Allahabad.

CONSTANT ATTENDANCE ALLOWANCE (BATTLE/ NON-BATTLE CASUALTY CASES)

5. Since Constant Attendance Allowance, where admissible, is shown separately in the Pension Payment Orders, the PDAs should, on their own, revise this element to Rs.300/- p.m. with effect from 1.1.1986 and disburse the arrears on account of the enhanced rate by adjusting the amount already paid on this account, till the date the same is/was payable as per the entries on the Pension Payment Orders. This need not await revision of disability pension.

6. DEPENDANT'S PENSION (BATTLE/NON-BATTLE CASUALTY CASES)

6.1 In the case of pensioners in receipt of dependant's pension as on 1.1.1986, only additional relief and consolidation of pension by PDAs in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *Ibid* would be admissible.

6.2 In cases where the officer had died on or before 31.12.1985 but dependant's pension has not been authorised for payment, it should be determined and authorised by the PSAs at the same rates and under the same conditions as in force hitherto, with the provision that with effect from 1.1.1986 the additional relief admissible on the amount of dependant's pension so worked out should also be added and the pension consolidated as per provisions of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *Ibid*.

6.3 In cases where the officers had retired on or before 31.12.1985 but died/died thereafter, the rates of dependant's pension will be the same as hitherto, with the provision of additional relief and consolidation as stated at para 6.2 above. However, there will be no means limit even in non-battle casualty cases. But the dependant's pension should be sanctioned by the PSAs in non-battle casualty cases subject to the claimant(s) furnishing an undertaking(s) to the effect that he/she/they were largely dependant on the deceased.

7. SECOND LIFE AWARDS IN RESPECT OF PERSONNEL BELOW OFFICERS RANK (BATTLE-ON-BATTLE CASUALTY CASES)

7.1 In the case of personnel in receipt of continuance of special family pension (second life award) on 1.1.1986, only additional relief and consolidation of pension by PDAs in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid* would be admissible.

7.2 In cases where the claim to continuance of special family pension had arisen on or before 31.12.1985 but the same has not been authorised for payment, it should be determined whether or not, with the provision that, with effect from 1.1.1986 the additional relief admissible on the amount of continuance of special family pension so worked out should also be added and the pension consolidated as per provisions of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May 1987 *ibid*.

7.3 In cases where the personnel below officer rank had retired or died on or before 31.12.1985 but the claim to continuance of special family pension has arisen thereafter, the award should be notified by the PSAs from the due date at the rates applicable thereto with the provision of additional relief and consolidation as stated at para 7.2 above. However, the condition regarding pecuniary circumstances of the claimants will not be applicable even in non-battle casualty cases. But the continuance of the special family pension should be sanctioned by the PSAs in non-battle casualty cases subject to the claimant furnishing an undertaking to the effect that he/she was largely dependent on the deceased.

7.4 It may be noted that in all the contingencies envisaged at para 7.1 to 7.3 above, the consolidated amount of the continuance of special family pension (second life award) will work out to Rs.375/- with effect from 1.1.1986 or from the date of commencement of such award, whichever is later.

LIBERALISED PENSIONARY AWARDS FOR BATTLE CASUALTY CASES

8. WAR INJURY PAY (WIP)

8.1 The officers and the personnel below officer rank in receipt of war injury pay will also be entitled with effect from 1.1.1986, to the disability element of pension at revised rates as given at para 1(i) and 1(ii) above.

8.2 All officers in receipt of war injury pay should apply directly to the concerned PSA in the manner prescribed in para 14.1 below.

8.3 In respect of the personnel below officer rank, the procedure outlined in paras 4.2 to 4.6 above should be followed with the modification that the Record Offices would indicate the existing rate of disability element of WIP and the percentage of disability in column 7(c) & 7(d) of Annexure 'C' as in the case of disability pension. The revised rate of disability 'C' as per the revised rates prescribed at para 1(i) and 1(ii) above for the appropriate degree of disability.

SPECIAL FAMILY PENSION (BATTLE CASUALTY CASES)

9. COMMISSIONED OFFICERS

9.1 In the case of Officers, liberalised Special Family Pension is admissible at enhanced rates at 75% of the basic pay last drawn for a period of seven years or till the deemed age of retirement, whichever is later. Thereafter, Special Family Pension is admissible at the rate equal to the normal retiring pension of the rank last held by the deceased. It should be possible for the Pension Disbursing Authorities, to determine whether in a particular case, Special Family Pension is being paid at enhanced rate or normal rate. Where it is being paid at enhanced rate, only additional relief in terms of para 4 of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid* is admissible which should be paid by the PDAs on their own. Where,

however, pension is being paid at the normal rate, it would be consolidated as follows:—

(a) Where the deceased belonged to any of the categories mentioned in para 3.2 above, normal rate of Special Family Pension should be revised in accordance with the RCP shown in the relevant table, provided the EP shown in the table under the relevant column tallies with the amount of normal rate of Special Family Pension authorised for payment by the PSA. Where the two amounts differ, the case should be referred to the concerned PSA in the manner prescribed in para 14.3 below.

(b) Where the deceased did not belong to any of the categories mentioned in para 3.2 above, only additional relief is to be paid by the PDAs on their own as per para 4 of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid*.

9.2 Where Special Family Pension in the case of officers is being paid at enhanced rates, PDAs should calculate the revised rates of the enhanced and normal rates separately and make suitable endorsements on the PPO/Check Register etc. so that when the pension becomes due for payment at normal rates, it should be possible for the PDAs to make the payment at the revised normal rates. The PSA should also indicate both the revised rates, if necessary, in the PPOs, in those cases which are referred to them by the PDAs.

9.3 Where Children Allowance is being paid in addition to the normal rate of Special Family Pension, action should be taken as indicated in para 9.3 of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid*.

9.4 Children Education Allowance, wherever authorised for payment should continue to be paid separately.

10. PERSONNEL BELOW OFFICERS RANK

The Special Family Pension in battle casualty cases of personnel below officer rank is equal to the reckonable emoluments last drawn. Accordingly, such pensioners will be entitled only to the additional relief and consolidation of pension in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid*.

LIBERALISED PENSIONARY AWARDS IN CASES OF BATTLE INOCULATION EXERCISES, ETC.

11. Disability and/or special family pensionary awards were granted at 90%/95% of the liberalised pensionary awards admissible in battle casualty cases, in respect of officers/personnel killed or disabled while—

(a) participating in (i) battle inoculation exercises in UP in 1973;

(b) participating in (i) battle inoculation exercises (ii) Mount Everest Expeditions and Sixth Trans-Himalayan Car Rally, 1985.

In all these cases, pensionary awards as per the provisions of this letter, shall be revised *suo moto* by CD/CP, Alahabad.

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

12.1 Wherever the Revised Consolidated Pension (RCP) is fixed on the authority of this letter, dearness relief should be allowed on such RCP on the new pattern with effect from 1.7.1986 and 1.1.1987 sanctioned vide Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare OM No.2587-P/C dated 22nd April, 1987. In future also, dearness relief should be paid as per the new pattern on the RCP *suo moto*.

12.2 Before making the payment of arrears on account of the RCP (as also dearness relief admissible thereon on the new pattern) fixed under these orders either by the PDAs on their own or by the PSAs, the amount of additional relief, if any, already paid in accordance with the provisions of this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid* should be adjusted by the PDAs before making the payment. While working out the arrears, care must also be taken to reduce the commuted portion of pension, if any, from the monthly RCP.

12.3 Where additional relief has not been paid so far by the PDAs as per this Ministry's letter dated 12th May, 1987 *ibid*, action should be taken by the PDAs to relax the RCP under
