Subject: Calculation of pro-rata pensionary benefits to the commissioned officers of Defence Services on permanent absorption in Central Public Enterprises on the basis of actual qualifying service.

Sir,

I am directed to state that grant of pro-rata pensionary benefits to Defence Service Officers on permanent absorption in Central Public Sector Enterprises is governed by the provisions of this Ministry's letter No.8(3)/85/A/D(Pens/the provisions of this Ministry's letter No.8(3)/85/A/D(Pens/the provisions of this Ministry's letter No.8(3)/85/A/D(Pens/Sers) dated 17th March, 1986. The pro-rata pension is granted according to the method given in Annexure-B to the above letter, and is related to the standard period of service of the rank of the officer. However, for Armed Forces officers retiring on superannuation on or after 1.1.1986, there is a change in the method of determining retiring pension. The concept of standard service of rank has been dispensed with and the pension is related to the actual qualifying service together with weightage appropriate to the rank last held, and the average emoluments, as laid down in this Ministry's letter No.1(5)/87/D(Pens/Sers) dated 30th October, 1987. This has necessitated a change in the method of computing pro-rata pension for officers who are absorbed in Central Public Enterprises on or after 1.1.1986.

- 2. The President is pleased to decide that the pro-rata pension of officers who are absorbed in Central Public Enterprises in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 17th March, prises in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 17th March, 1986, on or after 1.1.1986, will be determined in accordance with the provisions of this Ministry letter dated 30th October, 1987, but with no addition of weightage to the qualifying service.
- The pro-rata pension of officers of the Defence Services permanently absorbed in Central Public Enterprises who are governed by this Ministry's letter No.3(3)/86/A/D(Pens/Sers) dated 19.2.87 will also be determined in the same manner, where such absorption takes place on or after 1.1.1986.
