**Sub : Reservation of posts in Group 'C' and 'D' for ex-servicemen.**

Sir,

In terms of this Division's letter No. 2/11/79-SCT(B) dated 9-6-80 on the above subject, reservations to the extent of 14 1/2% and 24 1/2% of the vacancies in Group 'C' and 'D' posts, respectively have to be reserved by the public sector banks/financial institutions for the ex-servicemen, disabled ex-servicemen and dependents of servicemen killed in action. A question has been raised whether there is separate earmarking of reservations for the disabled ex-servicemen and the dependents of servicemen killed in action. The issue has been examined in consultation with the Bureau of Public Enterprises. Accordingly, I am directed to clarify that, as a working principle, the reservations for ex-servicemen for Group 'C' and 'D' posts in the public sector banks/financial institutions will be further bifurcated as under :

	Disabled Ex-servicemen/Dependents of servicemen killed in action.	Ex-servicemen
Group 'C'	4 $\frac{1}{2}$ %	10%
Group 'D'	4 $\frac{1}{2}$ %	20%

If some vacancies from out of the above 4 1/2% quota remain unfilled, these may be offered to other ex-servicemen. Conversely, if the quota of 4 1/2% is not adequate to appoint available disabled ex-servicemen and dependents of servicemen killed in action such persons may be appointed against the quota of the 10% or 20% otherwise reserved for the ex-servicemen and only the balance of unfilled reserved vacancies, if any, may be utilised for the ex-servicemen.

To enable the eligible disabled ex-servicemen and dependents of servicemen killed in action to avail themselves of these reservation quota, the BSRBs are advised to publicise such segments of reservations in their recruitment advertisements also.
