Subject:- Revision of pension rates for the non-regular officers granted Emergency and Short Service Commission from the ranks.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the question of revision of pension rates for non-regular officers granted Emergency and Short Service Commission from the ranks, w.e.f. 1.1.86 has been under consideration of the Government and it has been decided to continue with the existing rates as laid down in AI 6/S/65 as amended from time to time.

2. It has further been decided that w.e.f. 1.1.86 as in the case of Commissioned Officers, service rendered in the ranks prior to grant of Emergency or Short Service Commission will be counted in full towards Commissioned Service.
