Subject:- SUBMISSION OF "NON EARNING" LIVELIHOOD CERTIFICATE
BY THE GUARDIAN EVERY MONTH FOR FAMILY PENSION
PAYABLE TO CHILD/CHILDREN OF ARMED FORCES PERSONNEL

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No 6(10)/87/3206/B/D(Pen/Sers) dated 03 Sep 1987 regarding rationalisation of age limit for the purpose of entitlement of family pension for sons and unmarried daughters of Armed Forces personnel and to say that the question of removing the restriction of earning of livelihood for the purpose of stoppage of family pension has been under consideration of the Govt of India. It was felt that the condition was operating harshly on the sons/daughters as the rules do not define the quantum of livelihood that will be taken into account for the purpose of this condition.

2. The President is now pleased to decide that family pension payable to a son shall be stopped when he attains the age of 25 years and in the case of daughter when she attains the age of 25 years or when she gets married, whichever is earlier. The case of a son or a daughter of Armed Forces personnel who is suffering from any disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled so as to render him or her unable to earn a livelihood even after attaining the age of 25 years, will continue to be regulated under the provisions of Govt letter No A/49601/AG/PS4(e)/3363/B/D(Pen/Sers) dated 27 August 1987.

3. These orders will take effect from 18 January 1993.
