
DELEGATION OF FINANCIAL POWERS TO KENDRIYA SAINIK BORAD

Sir,

1. I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the delegation of financial powers to the Kendriya Sainik Board and authorities under him as contained in Appendix 'A' to this letter.
2. The exercise of the financial powers will be governed by existing instructions containing in the DSRs, financial Regulation (1983 Edition) as amended and Government of India letter/orders, issued from time to time on the subject and general stipulations contained in the subsequent paragraphs. Cases not covered under the delegated financial powers will, however be referred for sanction to the Ministry of Defence.
3. The financial powers to be exercised in consultation with IFA, shall be exercised by KSB authorities with prior consultation and financial concurrence of the IFA. For this purpose, IFA (Joint Staff) is designated as IFA to KSB.
4. The expenditure in exercised of the financial powers given in Appendix - 'A' will be debited to Major Head 2076 and Minor Head 800B(r). The exercise of financial powers is also subject to the availability of funds in the sanctioned budgetary allotment for the financial year.
5. The delegated financial powers will be exercised only by the authorities on whom these have been conferred and not re-delegated to any other officer. During absence on leave or pending assumption of charge by a regular incumbent, the officer discharging duties in officiating capacity will exercise full-delegated powers. A copy to the sanction issued in all cases will be forwarded to the CDA concerned.
6. KSB will continue to exercise the existing delegated powers to facilitate functioning due to their role & function in addition to the powers delegated vide this letter.

7. The exercise of the delegated financial powers is subject to the following conditions:-
- The expenditure should not be prime facie more than the occasion demands.
 - The canons of financial propriety should be observed.
 - The authority exercising the financial powers should be satisfied that the sanctioning of the expenditure is not contrary to any declared or known policy or decision of the Government.
 - The expenditure should be sanctioned subject to the availability of funds in the sanctioned budget grant under relevant heads.
8. The financial powers contained in Appx-'A' will take effect from the date of issue of this letter and the MoD letter dated 13 Jul 2004 is amended to the extent the powers have been delegated to Secy KSB.
9. This issues with the concurrence of the Ministry of Defence (Finance) vide their ID No 2728/Fin/Pen dated 22nd July , 2009.
