Subject:- Revision of restored 43% and 45% commuted portion of pension of Armed Forces absorbees who had drawn lump-sum payment on absorption in Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Bodies – Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission.

Sir,

The undersigned is directed to forward herewith a copy each of the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions (Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare) O.M. No.4/38/2-008-P&W(D) dated 15<sup>th</sup> September 2008 and dated 27<sup>th</sup> May 2009 on the above subject matter and to state that these orders will apply mutatis-mutandis to Armed Forces Personnel absorbees, who had drawn lump sum payment on absorption in Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies and have become entitled to restoration of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension. The percentage of commuted pension to be restored will, however, be 45% in the case of PBOR and 43% in the case of Commissioned Officers instead of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> mentioned in the above mentioned Office Memoranda.

2. The Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)/Autonomous body absorbees belonging to Armed Forces Personnel may apply for revision of their restored pension on a prescribed format enclosed as Appendix to this letter through their Pension Disbursing Agency (PDA) who, in turn, will forward the same duly authenticated to the Pension Sanctioning Authorities (PSAs) concerned. All the applications received from the Commissioned Officers and Personnel Below Officer Rank (PBOR) of all the three services will be forwarded to PCDA(Pensions) Allahabad except in case of Naval/Air Force Officers & PBOR absorbed on or after 1.11.1985, whose applications will be forwarded to their respective PSAs i.e. PCDA(Navy), Mumbai and CDA(Air Force), New Delhi.


3. PSAs may, however, wherever feasible also identify the affected cases and take suo-motu necessary action without waiting for applications from the pensioners.

4. Appropriate to the provisions contained in the above mentioned Deptt. of P&PW O.M.No. 4/38/2008-P&PW(D) dated 27.5.2009, the PSAs/PDAs are required to ensure that as a result of the revision, wherever the revised restored amount of commuted portion of pension plus Dearness Relief on notionally revised full pension as on 1.1.2006 works out to be less than what was admissible to the absorbed Armed Forces Personnel prior to 1.1.2006, the absorbed Armed Forces Personnel shall be allowed to draw higher pensionary benefits admissible till such time the revised pensionary benefits (i.e. revised restored amount of pension plus dearness pension and dearness relief on notionally revised full pension) admissible after revision works out to be more than what was admissible prior to 1.1.2006. The PSAs, while issuing the corrigendum PPOs under these orders, may accordingly incorporate a suitable guide note for payment of revised pension by PDAs accordingly.

5. This issues with the concurrence of the Ministry of Defence(Fin) vide their U.O.No.2647/Fin(Pen) dated 13.8.2009.


**Subject:-**Revision of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension in respect of Government servants who had drawn lumpsum payment on absorption in Central Public Sector Undertakings/Central Autonomous Bodies – Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission

The undersigned is directed to say that the restorable 1/3<sup>rd</sup> pension of the Government servants who had drawn lump sum payment in respect of pro-rata pension (1/3<sup>rd</sup> as well as 2/3<sup>rd</sup>) on absorption in a PSUs/Autonomous Bodies and have become entitled to restoration of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension as per the provisions of this Department's O.M. No. 34/2/86-P&PW dated 5<sup>th</sup> March 87 after 15 years from the date of commutation or 1.4.85 whichever is later, is regulated vide this Department O.M. No. 4/59/97-P&PW(D) dated 14<sup>th</sup> July 1998, OM No.4/79/2006-P&PW (D) dated 6.9.07 and dated 13.5.08 as clarified from time to time.

2. In pursuance of Government's decision on the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission, instructions have been issued for revision of pension of pre-2006 pensioners/family pensioners vide Deptt. of Pension & Pensioners Welfare's OM No.38/37/08-P&PW(A) dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008. Accordingly sanction of the President is hereby accorded for revision of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restorable pension of absorbees with effect from 1.1.2006, as explained hereunder:-

A. As on 01.01.2006, the full pension of the absorbees shall be notionally revised w.e.f. 1.1.2006 based on full pension as on 31.12.2005 in accordance with the instructions for revision of pension, issued for implementing the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission Recommendations vide OM No.38/37/08-P&PW(A) dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008. Benefit of additional pension available to old pensioners will be granted as indicated in para 3 below.

B. The restorable 1/3<sup>rd</sup> pension shall be the sum of the following:-  
i. 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of full pension as on 31.12.2005.  
ii. Dearness Pension on the full pension as on 31.12.2005

- iii. Dearness Relief upto AICPI (IW) average index 536 (Base year 1982=100) i.e. @ 24% of Basic full pension plus dearness pension.
- iv. Fitment weightage @ 40% of the full pension as on 31.12.2005

3. The quantum of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restorable pension as per para 2(B) above shall be further increased in respect of old pensioners as follows:-

Age of pensioner	Additional quantum
From 80 years to less than 85 years	20% of revised 1/3 <sup>rd</sup> restorable pension
From 85 years to less than 90 years	30% of revised 1/3 <sup>rd</sup> restorable pension
From 90 years to less than 95 years	40% of revised 1/3 <sup>rd</sup> restorable pension
From 95 years to less than 100 years	50% of revised 1/3 <sup>rd</sup> restorable pension
100 years or more	100% of revised 1/3 <sup>rd</sup> restorable pension

The amount of additional pension will be shown distinctly in the pension payment order.

4. Payment of DR shall be on full pension as per instructions issued from time to time and is subject to the condition that the absorbed employee was not re-employed/employed under the Central Government or State Government or a Corporation/Company/Body/Bank under them in India or abroad, including permanent absorption in such Corporation/Company/Body/Bank at the time of restoration.

5. The benefit of revision of restored amount of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension shall be admissible w.e.f. 1.1.2006 or from the date the commuted portion of pension is restored, whichever is later.

6. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of finance ( Department of Expenditure) vide their UO No4.2/11/2008-IC dated 10.09.2008.

**Subject:-** Revision of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension in respect of Government servants who had drawn lumpsum payment on absorption in Central Public Sector Undertakings/Central Autonomous Bodies -amount of the revised 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restored pension plus Dearness Pay (DP) & Dearness Relief (DR) on Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission to be not less than 1/3<sup>rd</sup> pre revised restored pension plus admissible DP & DR as already drawn up to 01.09.2008- Regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that the restorable 1/3<sup>rd</sup> pension of the Government servants who had drawn lump sum payment in respect of pro-rata pension (1/3<sup>rd</sup> as well as 2/3<sup>rd</sup>) on absorption in a PSUs/Autonomous Bodies and have become entitled to restoration of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension as per the provisions of this Department's O.M. No. 34/2/86-P&PW dated 5<sup>th</sup> March 1987 after 15 years from the date of commutation or 1.4.85, whichever is later, is regulated vide this Department's O.M. Nos. 4/59/97-P&PW(D) dated 14<sup>th</sup> July 1998, OM No.4/79/2006-P&PW (D) dated 6.9.07 and dated 13.5.08. In pursuance of Government's decision on the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission, instructions have been issued for revision of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restorable pension of such absorbees vide Deptt. of Pension & Pensioners Welfare's OM of even No. dated 15<sup>th</sup> September 2008.

2. The Deptt. of Pension and PW has received representations that implementation of instructions contained in OM dated 15.9.2008 is resulting in drop in the total amount of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restored pension plus DR in comparison to total amount of the 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restored pension plus admissible DP & DR as drawn by pensioners.

3. The President is pleased to decide that such absorbees, whose pre-revised 1/3 restored pension plus admissible DP and DR as on 1.9.2008 works out to be more than the amount of the revised 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restorable pension plus DR on the implementation of the Government's decision on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission in terms of instructions contained in OM dated 15.9.2008, shall continue to draw the pre-revised pension plus DP plus DR admissible in terms of orders existed prior to issue of the OM dated 15.9.2008 till such time the restored amount of revised pension in terms of instruction contained in OM dated 15.9.2008 plus admissible DR works out to be more than the pre revised 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restored pension.

4. The Administrative Ministries/ Departments are therefore directed to ensure that wherever the restored amount of the revised pension plus DR of such absorbees, in terms of instructions contained in OM dated 15.9.2008, becomes less than 1/3<sup>rd</sup> pre revised restored pension plus admissible DP & DR as already drawn, the absorbed employees should be allowed to draw the pensionary benefits admissible to them till such time restored amount of the revised pension in terms of instructions contained in OM dated 15.09.2008 plus admissible DR works out to be more than pre revised 1/3<sup>rd</sup> restored pension plus admissible DP & DR as on 01.09.2008. Necessary entries in the PPOs to this effect shall be made accordingly.

6. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) vide their UO No.106/EV/2009 dated 18.05.2009 and C&AG's U.O.No.30 Audit (Rules)/12-2009 dated 5.5.2009.
