- (i) Vide Govt. of India, MoD letter No. 17(11)/2018/WE/D(Res-1) dated 12.4.2019, order regarding one time contribution for ECHS membership and entitlement of ward in empaneled hospital/medical facilities in respect of World War-II Veterans, ECOs, SSCOs and Pre-mature Retirees has been issued by the Deptt. of Ex-Servicemen Welfare.
- (ii) DRZ(North), a subordinate ZonalOffice of DGR, established a DGR Stall at Rajouri on 13 April 2019 on the occasion of 'Rajouri Day' organised under the aegis of 25 Infantry Division. Total no. of 350 of serving personnel/Veterans/ Veer Naries/Dependents attended this event and were briefed about the variousschemes for Resettlement, Training, Employment and self-employment applicable to the Veterans and Widows.
