Important/Significant achievements in the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare including Minimum Government Maximum Governance during May, 2019:-

- (i) All Staff of DESW and its attached offices took pledge on 21st May 2019 under Anti-Terrorism Day.
- (ii) A total amount of Rs.16,21,40,653/- has been disbursed for Central share, maintenance of RSBs/ZSBs in the states of Punjab, UP and HQ NBGSB (Nepal Bhartiya Gorkha Sainik Board) (through AAO) under Defence Service Estimate Budget. The Progressive disbursement is Rs. 17,99,64,008/-
- (iii) 948 Ex-Servicemen (ESM) have been provided employment in Government, and 272 in the Non-Government Sectors. 53 ESM have been provided Self-Employment Schemes during the month.
- (iv) The Number of ESM/ dependents registered for Digital Life Certificate up to 30th April, 2019 is 5,03,262.
