CORRIGENDUM

Subject: - Liberalised pensionary awards for war widows and war disabled servicemen.

The following amendment is made to this Ministry's letter No. 200847/Pen-C/71 dated the 24th February 1972 on the above subject:-

Delete the existing note 2 in Annexure 1 to the above quoted letter and substitute the following:-

- * In the case of officers, as well as JCOs and ORs, if a widow re-marries her deceased husband's real brother and continues to live a communal life with and/or contributes to the sepport of the other living eligible heirs, she will continue to be eligible to the special family pension. On re-marriage with any other person, the widow will forfeit her right to the special family pension, but will be given a pension equal in amount to the ordinary family pension as though the servicem n had died in normal circumstances".
- This will take effect from the 20th June 1972.
