Revision of Bill Processing Agency Service Fees in tune with revised CGHS rates: On-line ECHS Medical Bill Processing.

Sir,

Further to Govt. of India MoD letter No.22A(10)/2010-US(WE)-Vol.-II dated 23<sup>rd</sup> Sept. 2015 and MoA between UTI-ITSL and ECHS signed on 29<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2015, regarding on-line processing of Medical bills in ECHS, I am directed to convey the sanction of the Competent Authority for revision of processing fee charges to be paid to UTI-ITSL, since the fees has been revised by CGHS vide Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Department of Health & Family welfare letter No. Misc 41/2013/CGHS (HEC)/CGHS (P) dated 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014. The processing fee ( all inclusive of processing fee & service tax/GST) shall be revised to 2% of claimed amount submitted by ECHS empanelled hospital, diagnostics laboratories, imaging centres and individuals for reimbursement claims, subject to a minimum of Rs.12.50/-and a maximum ceiling rate of Rs.750/- and shall be paid by the empanelled institutions/ ECHS members. The revised rates are inclusive of all taxes as applicable from time to time and shall be effective from the date of issue of this letter.
